- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ turn right with partner, bow on Mahbub
- 2 Spin right $1\frac{1}{2}$ times alone, hands on heart
- 3 New partner, turn left
- 4 Spin left, hands open, hold circle to finish
- 5 Circle walks in 4 paces, out 4 paces
- 6 Spin right, finishing opening hands from the heart to next partner.

The mood is rather light and joyful, with a softening of the heart as the dance progresses

It's a bit tricky to teach the words because they are unfamiliar, so this needs more attention to avoid the awkwardness arising when partners face each other singing uncertainly
