- 1 2 sidesteps right: head down, up, right, left.
- 2 2 sidesteps left: head down, up, left, right.
- 3 Spin right
- 4 2 sidesteps right, head rolls left to right and then down and up (as zikr)
- 5 As 4
- 6 1 sidestep left (with no words)
